Enrollment Numbers

- Enrollment as of February 14th: 490 students- see attached
- Average Daily Attendance (ADA) as of February 14th: 96.39%

Update on roofs on outbuildings at elementary

- There is one outbuilding (the old chemistry building, which is now storage for custodial and transportation supplies) that has an old roof, but it is not leaking
 - Our insurance company made a note of it the last time that they were here and have indicated that it needs to have a new roof

- When they were here, the tax maintenance note had already been negotiated
- While Prime Source Construction was here, I asked them to look at that roof and the roof on the music building as it is nearing the end of its life cycle
- Cost quotes are being obtained so that we can look at our options for future roof repair
- There are trees around the outbuildings that will need to be removed and/or trimmed by a professional tree service
 - In addition, there are dead limbs that need to be removed at the elementary in the playground area
 - Cost estimates will be obtained for tree work at the elementary

Authorization of the Chief Appraisers to prepare and present any appeals regarding the Comptroller's 2013

Property Value Study

- Mr. Benson, the Chief Appraiser, notified me that he wanted to appeal some of the values from the comptroller's report because he felt that some of the values were too high and were not in line as to what they should be
- I authorized him to appeal the values on our behalf

Safety Grant Awarded

- Our Guardian Program has about \$6,000 worth of medical supplies and gear needed to adequately equipment it
- *Prime Source Construction* has a donation program that funds local schools and school children on various projects
 - \$2,500 will be awarded by *Prime Source Construction* for medical supplies and equipment for our Multi-hazard program
