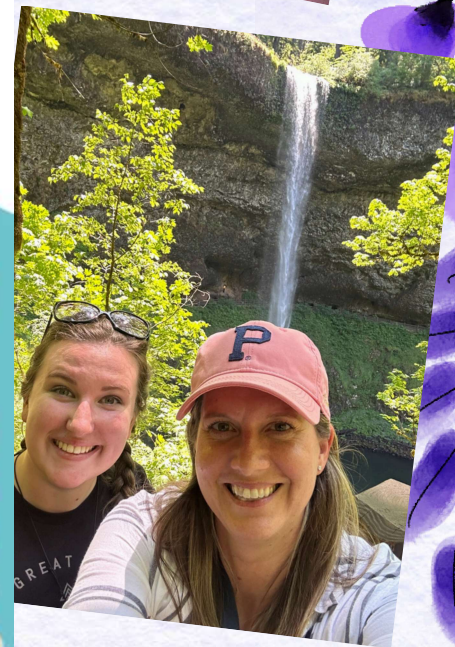

**KEY DATES:**

- April to Mid-May: Using their selection process, college presidents select primary and alternate college, CCWD, or OCCA women to represent their colleges at OILD.
- May 20: Name submission deadline.
- May 24: Primary nominees are confirmed; remaining spaces are offered to alternates.
- June 3: Final details mailed to participants.
- July 15-18: Institute week!

OILD is a four-day, all-inclusive professional development opportunity for community college women interested in leadership and personal and professional growth.

The Institute is supported by Oregon's community colleges. The all-inclusive fee of \$895 per person includes leadership training, materials, food/beverage, and the required group lodging at Big K Guest Ranch.
