This month in technology we have worked on the following:

- Offered training to teachers on CPS (Clickers) and Mimio, and other programs used in the district.
- Worked with Ener-Tel on alarm issues both with fire alarms and security systems throughout the district.
- Installed wireless connectivity in Davidson Gym.
- Replace/Repair equipment as needed such as document cameras, projectors, etc.
- Continually post updates and information on our webpage

- Rebuilt OHS Security Camera DVR Computer after it failed.
- Work with network filtering software to give access to websites needed and run reports about network traffic usage.
