Armando Cerna Elementary Student Council and myself are humbly requesting recognition for the heroic acts of Mrs. Jessica Ramon, a Fourth Grade Teacher at Armando Cerna Elementary, during the next board meeting on March 8th.

On February 1, 2016 at approximately 12pm a student in Mrs. Ramon's class began to choke on a piece of food. She immediately sent students to notify the nurse and 911 was called. Seeing her student's face turn red, beginning to salivate, and reaching for his throat, Mrs. Ramon performed the Heimlich maneuver. At first she was not getting a response, and the child was going limp in her arms. She continued the Heimlich maneuver several more times and was able to dislodge the food item that was blocking the child's airway. Mrs. Jessica Ramon, who is also a retired veteran and CPR trained, reacted quickly and calmly diminishing a tragedy. "Her heroic efforts contributed to a great positive outcome," as stated by EMS personnel.
