## Summer Curriculum Development Project: June 6-24, 2016

## Task to Accomplish

- Revise Pacing Guides
  - o Ensure all pacing guides are designed so that curriculum is completed by end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> nine weeks.
  - o Ensure standards for performance tasks in mathematics and English Language Arts (ELA) are taught in 1<sup>st</sup> semester.
- Develop Testing Blueprint for 4.5 and end of the nine weeks assessments in Math, ELA, and 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Science.
- Create units of study in Math, ELA, and 5th and 8th grade Science
  - o Units include the following:
    - Daily Lessons
      - Bell- ringers
      - Math Talks (Math)
      - Writing Incorporated (ELA, Science, Social Studies)
      - Whole Group Activates
      - Small Group Activates
      - Enrichment/Remediation
      - Closing
      - Exit Tickets
    - Formative Assessments
- Design Unit Syllabi to be posted on the website for each grade
- Create Writing Units in K-2
- Imbed Language standards across the curriculum in K-2

#### **Positions:**

 Project Leads- Curriculum Administrators and Specialists from the Office of Curriculum and Instruction will provide training and support for curriculum teams, set goals, monitor progress, and address emergent questions, concerns, or needs. • **Curriculum Team Writers-** Teachers with content and curriculum expertise in an assigned area will undergo training, participate in curriculum teams, work to complete project tasks as assigned by Curriculum Team Leaders, including the development and/or revision of pacing guides to meet district goals.

### Application Process:

• **Curriculum Team Writers** will be chosen by application. Principals will encourage all teachers who wish to work to apply. The Office of Curriculum and Instruction will coordinate the application process.

## Schedule of work:

• June 6-24, 2016 from 8:00 AM-5:00 PM: Curriculum Document Development/Revision

Curriculum teams will be broken into smaller groups based on content areas. Each of the chosen team members will work a maximum of 40 hours. Hours of work will be set by the Office of Curriculum and Instruction and communicated to the appropriate team members.
