 Perfect Attendance (no absences and no tardies) for any given year, December 1-31, 2021, will earn the student a \$100 gift card for the year.

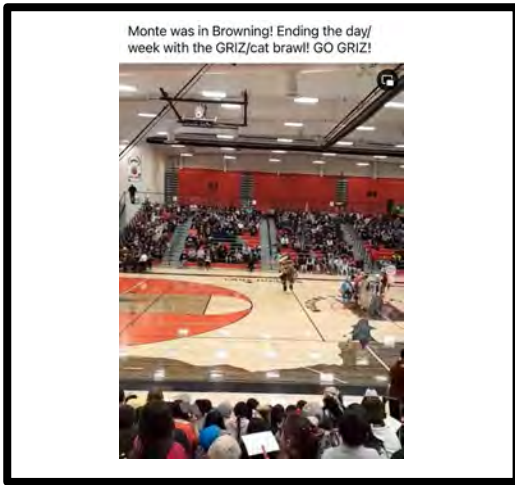
Weekly Incentives
