
### **Key Points**

- •TSU is ranked among the top 3 in HBCU student enrollment
  - •TSU is rated lowest among HBCU graduation rates.
  - •A positive correlation is revealed in comparing admission's requirements and graduation rates.
- •Among the private HBCUs the average required GPA is 2.6; these institutions have notably higher graduation rates.
- •Among the Public HBCUs TSU is the only institution classified as non-residential (mainly a commuter school).
  - •Graduation rates also show correlations with the institution's residency classification.








