
AGENDA ITEM: Discuss and consider approval for contracted services from Relay Graduate School of Education for an amount not to exceed \$90,000.

Galveston ISD Administration seeks to support the professional development of the assistant principals from Burnet and Weis through Relay's National Principal Academy Fellowship (June 18 – June 28). The program is a one-year program consisting of an intensive week in the summer followed by hybrid sessions throughout the year. The District wants to provide additional support to the instructional coaches from Burnet, Central and Weis through the Relay Instructional Leadership Development Institute which will be held June 18–27. The coaches are new to their roles at the respective campuses and will hone their skills in preparation for supporting their colleagues.


