RECOMMENDATION:

The Stevenson drain outfall has had a significant amount of soil erosion over many years. The area is meant to shed water to the nearby creek, which is part of the Wayne County water management system. It needs to be built back up with soil and stones to help guide the water properly and to protect the pipe.
