ANTICIPATED DATE OF COMPLETION OF PROJECT: Summer 2014

DESCRIBE THE PROJECT AND ITS BENEFIT TO THE COMMUNITY, AND IN PARTICULAR, TO CHILDREN: In our gym we are still using the original Volleyball stands from when HVHS opened in 1977. They are bent and broken in several places and we they are not adjustable. With new standards we would be able to adjust the nets to so that younger kids could learn on youth level and boys could play at the official men's net height. We use our volleyball net system year round in our PE classes, HVHS volleyball teams, 3 Rivers volleyball club, and adult open gym. In all the nets service Hundreds of children and adults each year. A new net system could last 20+ years before it needs replaced and would serve thousands of student/athletes.
