A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF MAYNARD SCHOOLS AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT TO REQUEST A WAIVER

WHEREAS, the Maynard School Board of Directors is committed to providing a high-quality education to all students within the district;

WHEREAS, certain circumstances or regulations may require the district to seek waivers to better address the unique needs or challenges faced by the district;

WHEREAS, the district is seeking a waiver of the Inclement Weather Calendar Waiver Request to allow the district to transition to an alternate calendar requiring 1,068 hours of student instruction due to the number of inclement weather days we have had. We are also asking the Division to waive Arkansas Code 6-18-213(b), which requires that the official reporting period for attendance shall be quarterly, with the actual number of days counted in each period to be no less than forty (40) no more than (50); allowing the district flexibility in the number of days to be made up.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Maynard School hereby authorizes the district administration to formally request a waiver for the Inclement Weather Calendar Waiver Request to allow the district to transition to an alternate calendar requiring **1,068 hours** of student instruction due to the number of inclement weather days we have had. We are also asking the Division to waive Arkansas Code 6-18-213(b), which requires that the official reporting period for attendance shall be quarterly, with the actual number of days counted in each period to be no less than forty (40) no more than (50); allowing the district flexibility in the number of days to be made up.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent or designee is authorized to take all necessary steps and actions to submit the waiver request, including providing any additional information or documentation required by the relevant authorities;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors expresses its support for the waiver request and acknowledges the importance of flexibility in addressing the unique needs and circumstances of the district.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
