Junior ROTC Aviation Support Request

Proposed date: Tuesday, September 10, 2019

Location: Bemidji Regional Airport

Concept of Operations:

Minnesota Air National Guard will fly a CH-47 Chinook helicopter from their St. Paul facility to the Bemidji Regional Airport on September 10, 2019. The Air National Guard will give students a static display tour of the aircraft and talk about aviation careers and capabilities of the CH-47. After the briefing, cadets will be given a 15 -20 minute orientation flight on the CH-47 and land back at the Bemidji Regional Airport. Total time on the ground at the airport will be one hour.

Three separate instructional periods will be conducted on that day; one for each JROTC class. Each class will meet as normal in the JROTC classroom during their designated period, board a bus at the high school and travel to the airport for the static display and orientation flight. At the conclusion of each flight, students will board the bus again and travel back to the classroom.

JROTC has class periods during 2^{nd} (9:56 – 11:26), 3^{rd} (11:33 – 1:03), 4^{th} (1:35 – 3:05).

Supervision: Aviation personal (two pilots and crew chief), JROTC Instructors (LTC John Naastad, CSM Ralph Rosemore) during each period, and as available Mr. Lutz, Mr. Stanoch, Mr. Resler, and Ms. Walter.

Additional seats are available during 4th period for school board members that wish to participate.
