APPROVAL OF AN INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT WITH MARRIOTT-SLATERVILLE CITY

REGARDING TAX INCREMENT FINANCING (TIF) RELATED TO THE CENTRAL BUSINESS

DISTRICT EAST COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AGENCY (CRA).

At the upcoming September 6th, 2023 Board meeting, a presentation by Doug Larsen will be given. Mr. Larsen is a consultant who is assisting Marriott-Slaterville City. His presentation will walk the Board through a proposed Marriott-Slaterville CRA. The project is titled: *Central Business District East*. (Project Area Booklet).

The goal of the project is to help current businesses expand and to attract new businesses. Marriott-Slaterville is asking the district to enter into an inter-local agreement to use 50% of the new taxes collected from the business expansion to help pay for a sewer line. Without the sewer line, business cannot expand.

Currently, Weber School Districts collects \$44,766 in annual property tax (see attached Net benefit analysis). With the development and the economic expansion, it is expected that Weber School District will collect an additional \$122,510. Fifty percent of this additional collection will go to help pay for the economic expansion and fifty percent of this additional collection will come to the school district.
