SUMMARY:

The Denton Central Appraisal District has requested its taxing jurisdictions to nominate up to five people to be considered for their Board of Directors. The nominations must be returned to the Denton Appraisal District by October 15, 2015.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

This item was presented to the Board as a workshop item.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Prior to October 30th a comprehensive list of the nominees will be compiled and this information will be sent to the taxing jurisdictions in the form of a ballot. The taxing jurisdictions will then choose by **written resolution** the candidate or candidates of their choice and then submit the names and the votes cast for each candidate prior to December 15, 2015.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

An appraisal district director must reside in the appraisal district for at least two years immediately preceding the date he or she takes office. Most residents are eligible to serve as a director. An individual that is serving on the governing body of a city, county, or school district is eligible to serve as an appraisal district's director.
