## SUBJECT: BUDGET AMENDMENTS FOR SPECIAL PROJECTS

**DATE:** March 31, 2015

This Budget Amendment is to reflect the Anticipated Increase in State Aid of \$2,638,833. The Increase in the *General Fund Revenues* is based on the change of *Provision 2 Base Year State Compensatory Enrollment* as determined by the *Texas Education Agency (TEA)* in the Summary of Finances dated, March 9, 2015. As previously anticipated, *TEA* has recently made the final determination of <u>not</u> to reduce the *Provision 2 Base Year State Compensatory Fund Program Required Allocation* has also Increased by \$155,550. These *Additional Funds* of \$155,550 must be designated to the *State Compensatory Fund Budget* and are being appropriated to Supplement the *Summer School Programs*.

In addition, the *M&O Fund* is transferring the remaining \$2,483,283 to the *Special Projects Fund*. This will Increase the *Special Projects Estimated Fund Balance* by \$2,483,283 from \$427,623 to \$2,910,906.

Additionally, Funds are also being appropriated in the *Capital Projects Budget* for the *District-Wide Metal Roofing Repairs* based on the 5-Year Facility Study. The *Total Amount Appropriated* is \$738,568 based on the attached *Tabulation*. This includes \$713,592 for the *District-Wide Metal Roofing Repairs* and \$24,976 for *Professional Services* to Mr. Davis Powell for a Total Amount of \$738,568. This will reduce the *Special Projects Fund Balance* by \$738,568 from \$2,910,906 to \$2,172,338.

Attached are the Budget Amendments to appropriate these Funds.
