Athletics Updates

Girls Basketball

• The Lady Rangers finished up their 2022-23 season by qualifying for the AA State Basketball Tournament. It was only the 2nd time our Girls team has qualified for State, 2004 was the last time. They qualified by winning the Section 7AA Championship with a 66-58 victory over Pequot Lakes. They ended the regular season in a three-way tie for the Mid-State Conference Championships with Detroit Lakes and Pequot Lakes. On the Individual side of things Tori Oehrlein was named to the Minnesota Coaches All-State Team for the 2022-2023 season.

Boys Basketball

• The Boys finished their season in the QuarterFinals of the Section 7AA tournament. They finished with an overall record of 17-11 and had two individuals named to the Mid-State All-Conference team (James Stokman, Will Meyer-Honorable Mention).

Wrestling

• John Paul Fitzpatrick finished his amazing career with a 4th Place finish at the A State Championship at the 152 lb Weight Class. He won the Section Championship by going 4-0 in the tournament, we had two individuals also place 5th in the Section and both are back next season (Gabe Ridlon, Brill Asraf).
