Unity School District - Board of Education Board Policy 447 Student Conduct Last Revised 11/13/2018

Students in the Unity School District shall be expected to act in such fashion that their behavior will reflect favorably on the individual student and on the school. Student conduct shall not be allowed to be a disruption to the learning environment, a school sponsored event, or an activity. Behavior that jeopardizes student and staff safety is prohibited.

Students are expected to abide by the code of conduct and behavior as outlined in the student handbook, and/or as stated in the rules and regulations established by building principals for each school. The repeated refusal to follow school rules will not be tolerated.

School administration may provide consequences including detention, suspension, and up to a referral for expulsion as is required for inappropriate behavior.

The Unity School District shall not discriminate in standards and rules of behavior, to curricular, extracurricular, pupil services, recreational or other programs or activities including student harassment, on the basis of sex, race, national origin, religion, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
