

## INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

### Transfer of 12 Pianos

**THIS AGREEMENT** is entered into by and between the undersigned political subdivisions of the State of Texas. This agreement is made pursuant to Section 44.031, Texas Education Code and satisfies the legal requirements therein.

#### Statement of goods to be transferred:
