# What were the actual savings compared to projected savings from the Jerome Prairie Elementary closure?

#### **REPORTED**

- Reduction of approximately 7 classified positions for a savings of about \$125,000
- Reduction of 2 teaching positions for a savings of about \$110,000 (licensed savings reflect this
  year's contract with a 10-day contract reduction; potential for a greater savings if a full year
  occurs)
- Total staff savings initial estimate = \$235,000

### **ACTUAL**

- Reduction of 4 full time classified employees in General Fund \$127,778 (an additional 4 employees in Title I and food service funds reduced)
- Reduced 2 teaching positions in General Fund \$130,682
- Total staff savings actual = \$258,460

#### What was the actual enrollment compared to the projected enrollment?

### What was the impact of bussing changes?

No new routes were added. Many routes were changed and the daily average time per route was .02 hours less this year, resulting in an approximate savings of \$81.90 for the entire 165 day year.

# What was the actual electrical and fuel savings vs. projected savings?

- Estimated electrical savings per year was \$15,693. Actual savings (through May) in 2013-14 was \$8,345
- Estimated fuel savings per year was \$31,396. Actual savings (through May) in 2013-14 was \$25,327
