

1 NOVEMBER-DECEMBER Know Your District's Needs

- Turn in participation agreement by November 8th
- Attend webinars
- Invite 3 educators to attend the webinar showcases to utilize Alaska's rubric to determine final ELA Programs for grant
- Form teams up to 5 to travel to the in-person meetings



2 JANUARY-MARCH Utilize District Curriculum Adoption Process

- Determine the budget for the adoption process with your ELA leadership team or your district process
- Attend the RTI conference to explore the curricular choices (travel covered by grant).
- Use your local district processes to recommend and adopt curriculum choice
- Begin implementation plan

3 APRIL - MAY District Implementation Plan

- Attend SOR Symposium with final curriculum decision and finish the implementation plan (travel covered by grant).
- Begin ordering materials and arranging professional development



4 SUMMER 2023 Purchase Instructional Materials

- Submit district implementation plan by June 1, 2023
- Purchase curriculum purchases and submit invoices to DEED
- Receive and disseminate materials to schools sites
- Make final arrangements with curriculum vendor for professional development

5 AUGUST New Adoption Year

- Provide professional development



6 SEPTEMBER Review Local Priorities

- Continue implementation
- Attend district curriculum cohort PLC



7 OCTOBER-MAY Communicate Through Collaboration

- Share data within curriculum cohort PLC
- Turn in completed grant impact survey by May 1st, 2024



8 Monitor and Assess the Effectiveness of the Materials.

- Continue communication and implementation within district cohort PLC
