As old man winter carries in the joys of Christmas, he also dragged in the misery of Covid. The transportation department has been diligently sanitizing the busses after each route and maintaining a surplus of masks for those who need one. The janitorial department has been sanitizing daily and we also applied Prevent X to all surfaces inside the buildings, classrooms and busses. Prevent X is applied with a special applicator that electrically charges the product to wrap around the surface. Prevent X kills germs up to 90 days inside and 30 days outside (according to the salesman).

As for the maintenance department we started the air handlers at the middle school. The air handlers bring fresh air in from outside, preheat it then forced to each room.
