

Parent Behavior Agreement Language Options

Refer to page 19 of the Student Code of Conduct

Option 1

Parental Involvement

The principal, campus behavior coordinator, or other appropriate administrator shall notify the parent of or person standing in parental relation to a student who has been placed in a disciplinary alternative education program (DAEP) or expelled of the parent's or person's right to request a behavioral agreement that specifies the responsibilities of the parent or person and student.

The behavioral agreement will specify the responsibilities of the student and parent/guardian. If followed, the agreement may result in a reduced disciplinary placement period (up to 10 percent of the original assignment), as outlined in the agreement. Reduction in the disciplinary placement period does not entitle the student to a different disciplinary placement. The decision to reduce, revoke or amend the disciplinary placement period is at the sole discretion of the school administration. Compliance with the agreement is required for the reduction to remain valid.

Note: Behavioral agreements are only offered for initial DAEP placements and are not available for repeated placements within the same school year.

Option 2

Parental Involvement

The district has not adopted a policy for parental involvement in school disciplinary placements under Education Code 37.0014.
