

The Port Orford-Langlois School Board met in a work session on March 9 2026 at 5:12 pm. The Board met in person at the Pacific High School Library, 45525 Highway 101, Sixes, Oregon, and simultaneously online via "Zoom". Board members present in person were Korinn Hockett, Carol Hacherl, Judy Miles, Angel Ashdown and Bob Brown. Staff present in person were Superintendent Aaron Miller, Principal Lisa Wendel, Principal DeAnna Williams, Teacher Donna Johannesmeyer, and Administrative Assistant Stephanie Griffith.

1.0 CALL TO ORDER/INTRODUCTIONS

2.1 Student Data

Donna Johannesmeyer gave a presentation on current testing results with DIBELS and I-Ready programs. A PowerPoint presentation is available in full on line.

Lisa Wendel distributed information regarding attendance at Driftwood School. She cited SWIS data. Attendance is not as good as it could be. She has been calling parents and sending out letters. April is typically tough as students become restless. Having a school counselor has been extremely helpful.

Aaron stated follow up information will be in future board reports.

DeAnna Williams provided data regarding attendance. All PHS students are 100% on track 14/14. All Family Academy students are 68% on track 4/6. In total POLSD is 90%, 18/20. Attendance goals per class are aimed at 90% and better.

Bob Brown asked why the district seems low compared to the rest of the state. Aaron responded there is a big difference between daily assessments and state assessments. Some causes were discussed, such as test anxiety and core language skills. DeAnna suggested practice session to get kids comfortable with test language and format. Judy Miles suggested getting kids comfortable with academic vocabulary.
