

June Teacher Tip: Combating Summer Slide

What is summer slide? It's the ground kids lose by not practicing and reinforcing what they learned last year. Studies show that student lose 17-34% of the material they learned in the previous school year over the summer break. Early elementary students are particularly prone to it....

What are the ways that you can prevent or minimize summer slide for your students?

- Keep on truckin' in other words: don't stop school!
- Encourage recreational reading Join your local library's summer reading program and/or read a minimum of 6 books over the summer
- Get outside do scavenger hunts and field trips
- Sneak math in Play cards and board games (ex. Möbi), cook (ex. make 1 and 1/3 of a recipe) and have them help at the store, gas station and on trips (ex. calculating prices and distances).
