Consider approval of student and employee out-of-state travel December 18, 2023

1. Background:

The Uvalde High School Varsity Los Coyotes Mariachi has been invited to perform in two concerts with the Boulder Chorale in Boulder, Colorado. The Artistic Director for Boulder Chorale read in *Rolling Stone* Magazine about the group winning the 2023 UIL State Mariachi Festival and has invited the group to perform the last weekend in April 2024, featuring music from Mexico.

2. Process:

The Boulder Chorale is extending an opportunity for the Uvalde High School Varsity Los Coyotes Mariachi to visit the Boulder community to celebrate music and the arts, bringing JOY to all who participate and an incredible experience for the students. This experience allows students to visit Boulder, Colorado, the University of Colorado, Museum of Contemporary Art and perform with a professional-level choir ensemble. This would be an opportunity of a lifetime for our students.

The out-of-state travel request is for Tuesday, April 23rd - Monday, April 29th. The itinerary would include the following:

Tuesday, April 23rd: Travel Day, Rehearsal, Dinner with Boulder Chorale

Wednesday, April 24th: Rehearsal, Lamont High School (clinic between the two high school Mariachi groups)

Thursday, April 25th: Rehearsal and Tour of the University of Colorado Friday, April 26th: Rehearsal & Concert at the Center for Musical Arts

Saturday, April 27th: Boulder Museum of Contemporary Art tour, Rehearsal & Concert

Sunday, April 28th: Rehearsal & Concert

Monday, April 29th: Travel Day

3. Fiscal Impact:

Dr. Vicki Burrichter, Artistic Director, has secured funding to cover roundtrip airfare, shuttle, hotel accommodations, and meals for the UHS Varsity Los Coyotes Mariachi, a group of 19 students, to include four chaperones and the Director of Mariachi.

A district representative will attend with the group to be the official spokesperson for our students at the event. However, the cost of the district representative will be at the District's expense.

4. Recommendation:

Administration recommends the approval of the Uvalde High School Varsity Los Coyotes Mariachi, Director of Mariachi, and a district representative to travel out of state to perform with the Boulder Chorale with the generosity of the Boulder Chorale Board of Directors covering roundtrip airfare, shuttle, hotel accommodations, and meals for 19 students, four chaperones, and the Director of Mariachi.
