GENERAL INFORMATION

- You may qualify to pay a reduced fee based on your income, others pay 100% for services received. Questions regarding our fees may be directed to the billing department.
- Do not lose your benefits with the Clinic.
 Remember to renew your membership once a year.
- Keep us informed of any changes with your address, phone number, and payment sources (Medicaid, Medicare, Private Insurance, etc.).
- To better serve you, we ask that you do not bring children with you if you have been scheduled to see the dentist. Children need your full attention and you will not be able to provide it if you are receiving services.
- Central Clinic Laboratory is open daily at 7:00 a.m. Check with the laboratory before coming in for lab tests for special instructions- e.g. fasting, special diet, 24 hour urine collection.
- When you come in to see the doctor, bring with you the medications you are taking.
- Order your refills on time. In case you run out of medications, report to the pharmacy.
- If you will not be able to keep your appointment, please call us at least 24 hours in advance to cancel or re-schedule your appointment.

SPECIAL NEEDS

- The clinic is equipped to provide services to patients with disabilities. If you or a family member is in need of an interpreter, please let us know.
- You have the right to accept or refuse treatment. With an "advance directive" you can declare ahead of time how and by whom medical decisions will be made on your behalf. For more information, you can talk to the staff at the clinic.

AFTER HOURS PHONE

The Center maintains a 24 hour answering service. Registered patients that need to speak to a physician or dentist after clinic hours may call their clinic number and request to be contacted by a provider on call.
