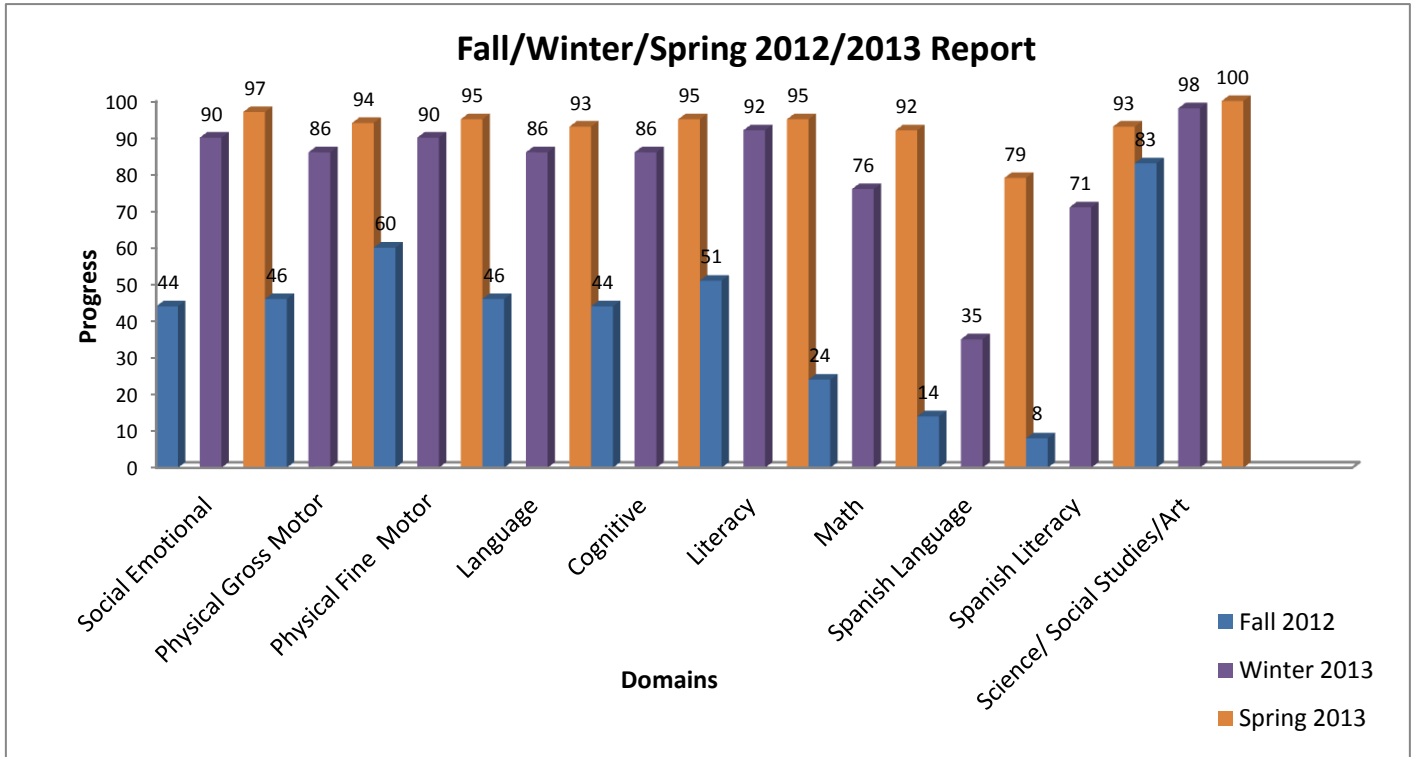


# ESC, Region 20 Head Start Program End of Year Summary Report

## School Readiness Results



The data presented in this table represents the progress of the children from the fall, winter and spring assessments, in each of the 12 domains required by the school readiness standard. The average total number of children assessed was approximately 450 children. The Spanish Language and Spanish Literacy results were based on the identification of 12 English Language Learners. Therefore, the results of the Spanish Language and Spanish Literacy results are not directly comparable to the other domains.

In all the domains children reached the 90% (meeting or exceeding pre-k expectations) school readiness goal for the year, the only domain in which did not meet 90% was the Spanish Language domain. The Spanish Language domain had an overall gain of 65% from the fall assessment to the spring assessment. Based on the results of the individual campuses, classroom teacher results, and overall program results, the ESC, Region 20 Head Start program will review program goals and objectives for the following school year. The children in the program demonstrated excellent progress, in all of the domains required by the Head Start Standards.
