Operational Impact

The Texas Education Agency fully funds the HB 3 Teacher Incentive Allotment. Further, 90% of TIA funds received by the district must be allocated as compensation to the assigned campuses of the teachers earning the designation. TIA funds must be distributed by August 31st each year.

This process will allow Denton ISD to obtain robust stakeholder input to implement a Teacher Incentive Allotment designation system developed by Denton ISD.
