

Survey Data


Of the roughly 3700 responses received to date, the data indicates significant concerns from our parent population in terms of returning their child or children to school. A summary is provided below:

Most parents will opt for distance learning. Only 36% want in-person learning.




South San ISD Return to School Parent Survey

The primary reason parents plan to opt out of in-person instruction is due to dissatisfaction of TEA guidelines.




South San ISD Return to School Parent Survey

Parents of elementary children were most strongly represented.




South San ISD Return to School Teacher Survey

Survey Data

Of the roughly 750 responses received to date, the data indicates significant concerns from our teachers in terms of returning to school for face to face instruction. A summary is provided below:


Most teachers prefer distance learning instruction. Only 10% want to provide face to face instruction. 30% will work in whatever way is needed.



South San ISD Return to School Teacher Survey

The primary reason teachers plan to opt out of in-person instruction is due to worries about the spread of COVID-19 during face to face teaching (25%) . Another roughly 30% prefer distance learning due to being a caregiver of a high-risk person or because they have a documented medical condition.
