Guyer High Girls Soccer Team win UIL Class 4A State Championship

Guyer High School's girls soccer team made history this season, winning the UIL Class 4A State Championship – the school's first for a female varsity team.

Guyer has now won a state championship by both a male and female team during the 2012-13 school year.

The Lady Wildcats finished the regular season with a 20-1 record and the District 11-4A title. Guyer defeated Mineral Wells 5-1 and Gainesville 4-2 in the first two rounds of the state playoffs. The Lady Wildcats then defeated both Birdville and Stephenville by 3-0 margins to advance to the regional tournament.

Guyer defeated Canyon Randall in the regional semifinal 3-1 and posted a 3-0 shutout over Byron Nelson to claim the 4A Region I title and a berth in its first state tournament.

The Lady Wildcats clinched a spot in the state championship game with a 4-2 victory over Magnolia and brought home the trophy with a 2-1 victory over defending-state champions Highland Park High.

The win ended a 49-game unbeaten streak for Highland Park and capped a playoff run that saw Guyer outscore its opponents 27-7 and end the season on a 19-game winning streak. Junior forward Hannah Alspach, the District 11-4A Most Valuable Player, was also named the state tournament's MVP.

In 4A competition, Denton High claimed the highest school honor, finishing as the regional runner-up for the third consecutive year with 136 points and Guyer High scored 99 to finish fourth.

In 5A competition, Ryan High finished 11th with 41 points - one of only two Denton County 5A schools to achieve 40 or more points at the 5A Region I meet.
