



Goal and Action Steps

K-2

Goal: By the end of 2nd trimester, 85% of all students will show greater than 81% accuracy and automaticity of the learned phonics skills as seen on the Benchmark Advance Cumulative Word Fluency assessments.

Goal: By the Spring iReady Benchmark assessment, 85% or more of all students in K, 1, and 2 will be placed mid or above grade level for phonics on the iReady Phonics Grade-Level Placement.

Action Steps:

- Implement consistent phonics instruction using Benchmark Advance resources
 - Blending and Building Words
- Progress Monitor Each student will be progress monitored weekly on Benchmarks Phonics word lists. Teachers will utilize the weekly progress monitoring data at PLCs to discuss accuracy and automaticity of the learned phonics skills.

Goal: By the end of 2nd trimester, 85% of all students will show accuracy at an average of 75% or greater on "Cloze Activity" passages utilizing the Benchmark Advance T2/T3 Vocabulary weekly lists.

Goal: By the Spring iReady Benchmark assessment, 85% or more of all students in 3, 4, and 5 will be placed mid or above grade level for vocabulary on the iReady Vocabulary Grade-Level Placement.

Action Steps:

- Implement intentional vocabulary instruction using Benchmark Advance resources
 - <u>Vocabulary Instructional Strategies</u>
 - <u>Vocabulary Graphic Organizer</u>
- Progress Monitor Each student will be progress monitored weekly on Tier 2/Tier 3 Benchmark List in a cloze activity format. Teachers will utilize the progress monitoring data at PLCs to discuss mastery and flexibility of word use.

Due to our district strategic plan goal of all 8th graders successfully completing algebra, we chose to focus on algebraic thinking across the grade levels.







Goal: By the end of the 2nd trimester, 85% of the 1st-5th grade students will show greater than or equal to 75% mastery within solving word problems as seen on the Big Ideas bi-weekly assessments.

Goal: By the Spring iReady assessment, 85% or more of all students in K-5 will be placed mid or above grade level.
