Agenda Item: Consider and take action regarding approving a Resolution declaring Bexar County 4-H as an extracurricular activity and Bexar County 4-H extension staff adjunct faculty status so that student absences for these events can be marked as excused extracurricular absences.

CONSENT ITEM

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board approve Bexar County Texas 4-H organization for recognition and eligible for extracurricular status consideration under 19 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 76.1, pertaining to extracurricular activities.

IMPACT/RATIONALE:

The 4-H program requires all students who participate in events to abide by UIL rules and regulations. The resolution agreement would permit 4-H events to be marked as an "excused extra-currricular absence" per the requirequirements of the agreement. If a district chooses to enter into the agreement with 4-H, the 4-H sponsors who support students and their projects are designated as "adjunct faculty". As such, these sponsors are required to verify that students are eligible per UIL rules to participate in 4-H events, and an absence from school for such an event will be recorded as an excused extra-curricular absence, much like a band or athletic absence.
