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## Teacher Evaluation-Student Achievement Goals 2018-19 Proficiency Targets

### Minimum Proficiency Targets:

**Elementary Schools (grades K-5):** 50% of all students in grades K-5 will show growth from fall benchmark to spring benchmark using the iStation Benchmark Assessments.

**Middle Schools (grades 6-8):** The average math and reading Student Growth Percentage (SPG) on STAR assessments will be 30% or higher.

**Mt. Harrison Jr High (grades 6-8):** 50% of all students in grades 6-8 will show adequate Lexile growth from fall benchmark to spring benchmark as indicated by national Lexile growth expectations.

**Minico High School (grades 9-12):** The graduation rate will increase by 1%, Ds and Fs will decrease by 10%, and 80% of parents will be contacted as outlined in the rubric below.

**Mt. Harrison High School (grades 9-12):** The graduation rate will increase by 4%, and Ds and Fs will decrease by 5% as outlined in the attached rubric.
