

ITEM FOR ACTION**APPROVE NEXT SUPERINTENDENT CRITERIA****SUMMARY**

The board will consider for approval the Next Superintendent Criteria for the superintendent search.

BACKGROUND

Board policy CBB requires that the board adopt the standards and criteria to be used in hiring a superintendent at an open meeting of the board in which the public has had the opportunity to comment. The board approved the process and timeline for the superintendent search on November 4. On December 9 the board will consider for approval the Next Superintendent Criteria developed by search consultants Human Capital Enterprises based on input received from the board and more than 1,600 students, families, staff and community members, and revised with input from the board and additional community feedback. The initial draft was reviewed and discussed in a work session on December 3, and the revised draft will be considered in a work session prior to its consideration for approval in the regular business meeting on December 9.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the board approve desired criteria for the district's next superintendent.
