All previous Health/Life Safety projects have been completed and are in compliance.

WHEREAS, BLDD architects have determined that the detectable warning (truncated domes) is in need of Replacement in kind.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Superintendent to utilize the health life safety money in order to replace the New Berlin Elementary detectable warning (truncated domes).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approve the work the certified estimate from the Architect in the amount of \$8,000 for the replacement of the truncated domes.
