2. Background:

Districts are required to present the STAAR accountability results by September 30th. At present, no ratings have been published due to a temporary restraining order issued by Judge Karin Crump, which concerns the state's adjustments to the metrics for evaluating school performance. Ratings for public schools are primarily based on students' performance on the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR), an annual statewide standardized test that measures students' understanding of the state-mandated core curriculum. Today, we will provide an update on the data reflecting our students' performance.
