Dear Mrs. Hope Worsham and Mrs. Brooke McCain,

The Mountainburg Public School District is seeking a waiver for Standards for Accreditation 1-A.5 which requires that "Each public School district shall comply with the laws of the State of Arkansas and the rules of the Division regarding class size and teaching load." The District is seeking a waiver under Ark Code Ann. 6-15-202(b)(2)(A).

Current enrollment in third grade is 52 with two classrooms available. This number reflects an increase in that grade level cohort of students from 48 in the spring of the previous year, up to 52 as of October 1 of this year.

The building guiding coalition was involved in decisions regarding staffing and grade level assignment through the spring and summer months, and staffing adjustments were made late in the summer to meet other shifts in enrollment. Enrollment is reported and reviewed at each board meeting. The request for Board Approval to seek a waiver on class size was placed on the board agenda, discussed in a board meeting open to the public on September 16, 2024, and approved by the Board at that time in the event enrollments exceed class size limits on the October 1 reporting date, which did occur.

We are glad to experience the increase in enrollment and to welcome these families into our school. It is difficult for a district our size to hire an additional teacher. We have full confidence in the ability of our third grade classroom teachers to manage the addition of one or two students over the class size limit and ensure their students are fully engaged in daily learning. In the event class sizes reached a need for more than 3 students over the limit we would seek alternate solutions such as a split grade level class, or a paraprofessional, etc.

We appreciate your consideration of this request. Please see the Board resolution.
