- Our PBIS Obstacle Course in celebration of improved Hallway behavior was a hit! Tyler and Paul, our PE teachers did a phenomenal job setting up the course and ensuring all students were able to successfully participate in the event. Students couldn't stop talking about prior to and following the fun and challenges they had on the course.



- The Child Wellness Fair was a huge success! We were able to service 95 students, identify 8 students who need either a full evaluation or continued screening in fall, catch one medical situation in need of care beyond our abilities, identify one hearing loss situation requiring further attention, serve 120 meals, enroll five additional 4K students, and build relationships with vendors who were thrilled to be a part of this fantastic event! We will repeat this, bigger, next year.



- To further our learning about Lucy Calkins Writing Units of Study, Learning Labs were held this past month. One person at most grade levels taught a writing lesson inviting the remainder of the grade level teachers in to watch for particular student behaviors and help further learning. A protocol is followed in this process both during the observations in the classroom and following the observation as the lesson is reflected upon. Each teacher walks away from this learning situation with a plan to try something new in their own teaching ensuring students are making accelerated progress.
- I have personally met with almost all of my 47 teachers to review mid-year goals progress ensuring our students are receiving needed interventions and being challenged to grow to reach their highest potential.
