Per statute, the Board must have a public hearing to formally adopt an E-Learning Plan. The E-Learning Plan is adopted on a multi-year cycle and designed for use in specific emergency scenarios when regularly scheduled learning cannot be held (i.e., 'snow days'). Please note that the formal E-Learning Plan is separate and apart from our Hybrid A/B schedule, our online-only learning model, and any potential district-wide remote plan that could need to be explored in a future scenario during the pandemic.
