




Xello & EDP Support

Schoolcraft students in 4th-12th grade used the Xello platform throughout the school year to explore careers, complete lessons, and update their careers interests. Schoolcraft students logged into Xello a total of **4,036 times** this year with an average of **7.19 times** per student. Students logged in the most during the month of May with over 1,200 log-ins.



300 Careers of Interest saved by students in grades 3-5 ♥(Top 5)



KRESA supported the event with 7 Career Consultants/Coaches who volunteered at budgeting stations to guide students through the simulation.
