SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from Advanced Connections Inc. in the amount of \$242,373.00 for the purchase of security cameras for the Strickland Middle School campus renovation.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This equipment provides internal and external security cameras, as well as video storage.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The passage of this quote will allow for the security cameras to be purchased from and installed by Advanced Connections Inc. through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative (TIPS) contract. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne by this project's 2018 Bond Authorization budget.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to follow camera placement compliance guidelines for physical security.
