CLC (LOCAL)

The principal or designee shall promulgate rules and regulations concerning the operation and parking of vehicles on school property.

The principal or designee may suspend or revoke the driving and parking privileges on school property of violators of vehicular rules and regulations.

Violators of traffic and parking regulations shall be warned. After a warning has been issued, failure to comply with these regulations may result in the vehicle being towed, at the owner's expense, from District property.

Reinstatement of driving and parking privileges may be permitted. A reasonable reinstatement fee may be assessed.
