

VEHICLE AND
PARKING LOT
REGULATIONS

Students desiring to park on high school parking lots of the District shall annually acquire a parking permit for a fee of \$35.00

VIOLATIONS

All laws and ordinances regulating traffic on a public highway or street apply to the operations of vehicles on school property. Education Code 37.102(b).

Identification may be required of any person on school property. Persons with no legitimate business purpose shall not be on school property, including, but not limited to, school parking lots, and may be ejected on the person's refusal to leave peaceably on request. Education Code 37.105.

Additionally, the Board adopts the following rules for the operation and parking of vehicles on high school property:

- 1. All students parking on high school parking lots shall have a valid parking permit.**
- 2. All parking permits must be displayed with the front facing outward on the rear view mirror or windshield.**
- 3. Permits may not be transferred to another car. Permits may only be displayed on the vehicle for which it is registered.**
- 4. Students shall not park in any teacher parking space (which is marked with a "T"), administrator parking space (which is marked with an "A"), visitor parking space (which is marked with a "V"), or any other undesignated area (which is either marked as "No Parking" or not as space between two yellow lines).**
- 5. Visitors to the campus shall park in designated visitor parking spaces.**

A person who violates any of the rules listed above is subject to receiving a citation and/or having the vehicle towed. A violation of any of rules 1-5 constitutes a Class C Misdemeanor. Education Code 37.102©.

The cost of towing any vehicle shall be borne entirely by the student whose vehicle is towed.

**REVOCA
TION
AND REINSTATE-
MENT OF PARK-
ING PRIVILEGES**

The Principal of his or her designee may suspend privileges of any person who violates any of these rules or regulations. Reinstatement of driving and parking privileges may be permitted at the discretion of the Principal or his or her designee and shall require a new parking permit fee of \$35.00

~~The principal or designee shall promulgate rules and regulations concerning the operation and parking of vehicles on school property.~~

~~The principal or designee may suspend or revoke the driving and parking privileges on school property of violators of vehicular rules and regulations.~~

~~Violators of traffic and parking regulations shall be warned. After a warning has been issued, failure to comply with these regulations may result in the vehicle being towed, at the owner's expense, from District property.~~

~~Reinstatement of driving and parking privileges may be permitted. A reasonable reinstatement fee may be assessed.~~
