Family & Community Collaboration

Goal 1: Prioritize and implement intentional and purposeful partnerships.

Instructional staff communicate with parents via telephone, email, newsletters. We will be hosting family nights inviting parents to come and participate in activities with their students. All events are posted on the Ipalook Facebook page and flyers are posted on campus as well as teachers send out to parents.

mClass testing windows was opened from September 3-17,2024, however due to some technical issues. But they have been resolved.

All instructional staff are required to participate in PLC and grade level meeting which are held every Wednesday, unless a District Inservice is scheduled.

Walk throughs have begun and teachers are receiving feedback to help provide best practices for student learning.

Goal 4: Graduate bilingual students

The school year, we began with 2 ILC teachers, starting Monday, September 16, 2024, we will be adding 1 additional ILC teacher. This means that all K-5 students will be receiving ILC.

K-3 grade teachers are required to provide a minimum of 240 minutes of instruction and 4-5 grade teachers are required to provide a minimum of 300 minutes of instruction. Administration has work with all teachers reviewing class schedules to ensure that students are receiving the amount of instruction for their success.

Student Social & Emotional Wellbeing

Goal 5: Facilitate & maintain culturally, emotionally, & physically safe learning environments



PBIS is being implemented throughout the building. The PBIS committee has been working with all staff members (instructional and paraprofessional) on ensuring that everyone implementing PBIS across all grade levels. We are also incorporating CHAMPS into PBIS to assist in classroom management.

The school counselor and the SEL counselor are working with students on areas of bullying and ensuring that students feel safe at school.
