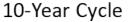

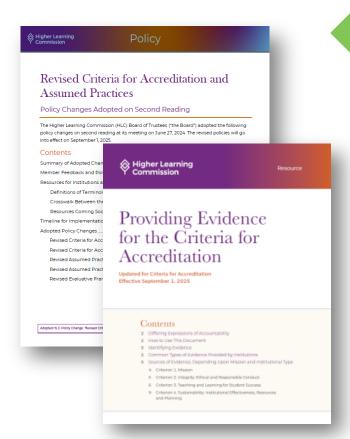

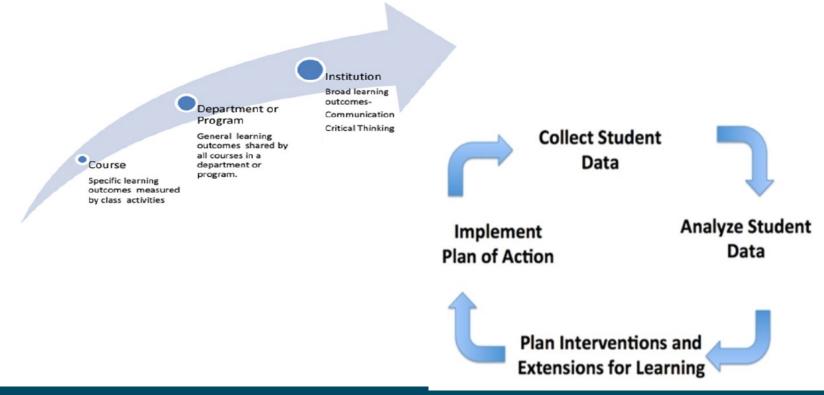
- 3E. Assessment of Student Learning
