The 1st Semester just ended and it was a great 18 weeks. I witnessed a lot of great things happening in our classrooms. Teachers are working hard to challenge your child and build a relationship with them in the process. We have noticed a big change in our classrooms with the new cell phone policy being implemented this year. We ask all students that have a cell phone to not have it while in class and it has made a tremendous difference in your child's learning. Please remind your child the importance of learning and keeping the cell phone distraction out of the classroom.

If your child is struggling in a class, has missed several classes and has an incomplete then I have a solution to the problem. Monday through Thursday from 3:30pm -5:50 pm we offer after school tutoring with a certified teacher. Students who have taken advantage of this opportunity in the past have definitely seen an impact with their grades.

Our attendance the 1st semester was good but we did not hit our goal of 95%. Here at Hidden Valley High School, our daily academic focus is for each student to be here everyday, be prepared and attend every class and graduate. As a school our target is 95% for the school year and I need your help to make sure your child is at school everyday. Recent studies indicate a relationship between attendance and graduation rates. Students who miss between 5-9 school days in one high school year have a 63% chance of graduating while students who miss 0-4 school days have a 87% of graduating. By working together we will help your child reach their goal of graduating.
