



Areas for Continued Focus & Improvement

Overall

- Although they improved their numeric scores, 4 campuses had the lowest rating (CCE, LPE, RRE, CCMS)
- These schools will receive additional differentiated support including:
 - Monthly Campus Support Team Meetings
 - Weekly 1:1 leadership support directly from Chief Academic Officer and Directors of Elementary/Secondary Education
 - Frequent instructional walks with district leadership
 - Special education and intervention pilots aimed at improving services and staffing
