PROPOSED LOCAL OPTION LEVY



What is Measure 29-184?

Measure 29-184 is a proposed local option levy which was referred to the voters by the Neah-Kah-Nie School Board. If passed the measure would authorize an increase in property taxes that would be used to fund District operations. This measure will appear on all voters' ballots in the District boundaries for the May 20, 2025 election.

If passed, what would the measure cost?

If the measure passes, property owners within the District would pay \$0.75 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. The owner of a home assessed at \$250,000 would pay \$ 5.48 more per month or \$ 65.76 more per year. The property tax would continue for five years and would raise a total of \$11,040,000.

What happens if Measure 29-184 is passed by voters?

If passed by voters on May 20, the Measure would raise property tax revenue estimated at \$11 million over five years. The tax revenue would fund:

- Teachers and staff
- Transportation
- Meals
- Extracurricular Activities
- Maintain small class sizes
- Maintain programs such as the arts, athletics, career-technical education, dual credit programs, and district transportation

What would happen if Measure 29-184 is not passed by voters?

If the measure does not pass, the above operational priorities would not be funded and property taxes would not be increased. The current property tax expires in June 2025.

PROPUESTA DE IMPUESTOS DE OPCIÓN LOCAL

¿Qué es la Medida 29-184?

La Medida 29-184 es una propuesta de impuesto de opción local que fue remitida a los votantes por la Junta Escolar de Neah-Kah-Nie. De aprobarse, la medida autorizaría un aumento en los impuestos prediales que se utilizarían para financiar las operaciones del Distrito. Esta medida aparecerá en las papeletas electorales de todos los votantes dentro de los límites del Distrito para las elecciones del 20 de mayo de 2025.

Si se aprueba, ¿cuánto costaría la medida?

Si se aprueba la medida, los propietarios de viviendas dentro del Distrito pagarían \$0.75 por cada \$1,000 del valor catastral de la propiedad. El propietario de una vivienda con un valor catastral de \$250,000 pagaría \$5.48 más al mes o \$65.76 más al año. El impuesto predial se mantendría durante cinco años y recaudaría un total de \$11,040,000.

¿Qué sucede si los votantes aprueban la Medida 29-184?

Si la medida es aprobada por los votantes el 20 de mayo, aumentaría los ingresos del impuesto predial en aproximadamente \$11 millones durante cinco años. Estos ingresos financiarían:

- Maestros y personal
- Transporte
- Comidas
- Actividades extracurriculares
- Mantener clases con tamaños pequeños
- Mantener programas como los de artes, atletismo, educación técnica y profesional, educación dual programas de crédito y transporte distrital

¿Qué pasaría si los votantes no aprueban la Medida 29-184?

Si la medida no se aprueba, las prioridades operativas mencionadas no se financiarán y no se incrementarán los impuestos prediales. El impuesto predial actual vence en junio de 2025.

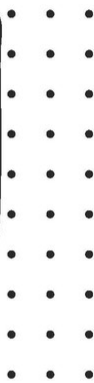
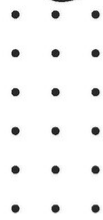
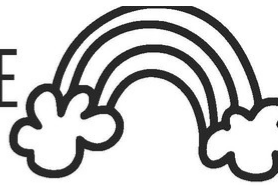
