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BOARD OF MANAGERS ORDER **DECEMBER 15, 2020**

AN ORDER GRANTING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES EXEMPTION FROM COMPETITIVE PURCHASING REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE ACQUISITION OF SUPPORT, RESOURCES, AND TRAINING TO ASSIST LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IN CREATING NON-ARREST PATHWAYS TO ADDICTION TREATMENT AND RECOVERY

WHEREAS, the Nueces County Hospital District (the "Hospital District") is a body politic and corporate and a political subdivision of the State of Texas, established and created pursuant to the Texas Constitution, Article IX, Section 4 and the Texas Health and Safety Code (the "Health Code" or "Code"), Chapter 281, and operated in accordance with the Health Code and other applicable laws of the State of Texas, including the Texas Local Government Code (the "Local Government Code"), Chapter 262;

WHEREAS, the Board of Managers of the Hospital District (the "Board") is the governing body of the Hospital District, pursuant to Health Code, §281.048, and pursuant to the collective authorities of the Health Code, §281.047 and §281.048, the Board has, and at the time of adoption of this Order had, full power and authority to manage, control, administer, and to adopt rules governing operation of the District;

WHEREAS, the term "purchase" means any kind of acquisition, including professional services, of an item as set forth at Local Government Code, §262.022(6) and the purchase of professional services may be exempted from the competitive purchasing requirements of Local Government Code, §262.023, as authorized by Local Government Code, §262.024(a)(4);

WHEREAS, the Hospital District is authorized to provide public health and mental services pursuant to Health Code, §281.094; and

WHEREAS, the Hospital District desires to acquire the professional services of the Police Assisted Addiction and Recovery Initiative (PAARI) to provide support, resources, and training to assist law enforcement agencies in creating non-arrest pathways to addiction treatment and recovery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF MANAGERS OF THE NUECES COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT, THAT:

1. As authorized by Local Government Code, §262.024(a)(4), the Board hereby grants an exemption to the competitive purchasing requirements of Local Government Code, §262.023, for the Hospital District's acquisition of support, resources, and training to assist law enforcement agencies in creating non-arrest pathways to addiction treatment and recovery from of the Police Assisted Addiction and Recovery Initiative (PAARI).
2. The Administrator shall be and is hereby expressly authorized and directed to do and perform all acts, and to execute all instruments, contracts, agreements, and any other related documents, whether or not herein cited, as required to carry out the intent, terms, and provisions of this Order, such execution to be conclusively evidenced by the performance of such acts.
3. The Administrator, in his capacity as the Secretary of the Hospital District Board, be and is hereby legally authorized and empowered to certify these orders and that the provisions hereof are in conformance with the laws of the State of Texas and the Governing Board Bylaws of the Hospital District.
4. This Order shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon and after its passage.
