## FAMILY ENGAGEMENT SURVEY

Every five years, the Department of Public Instruction requires districts to survey families of children with disabilities receiving special education services to determine levels of family engagement. The survey measures the percentage of parents with a child receiving special education services who report that schools facilitated parent involvement to improve services and results for children with disabilities.

Survey preparation will occur in January 2024, and the survey will be opened up to Unity families starting early in February 2024. Families will receive a letter or an email with password information to access the survey. The survey is also a tool for planning evidence-based and parent-recommended practices to engage families in their child's education. Administrators and educators are encouraged to use the results to develop beliefs, skills, and systems within their schools to engage families in special education, IEP meetings, and their children's education. DPI will generate reports for Districts by September 2024. Next school year, Unity will develop a district family engagement plan to submit to DPI based on report results.
